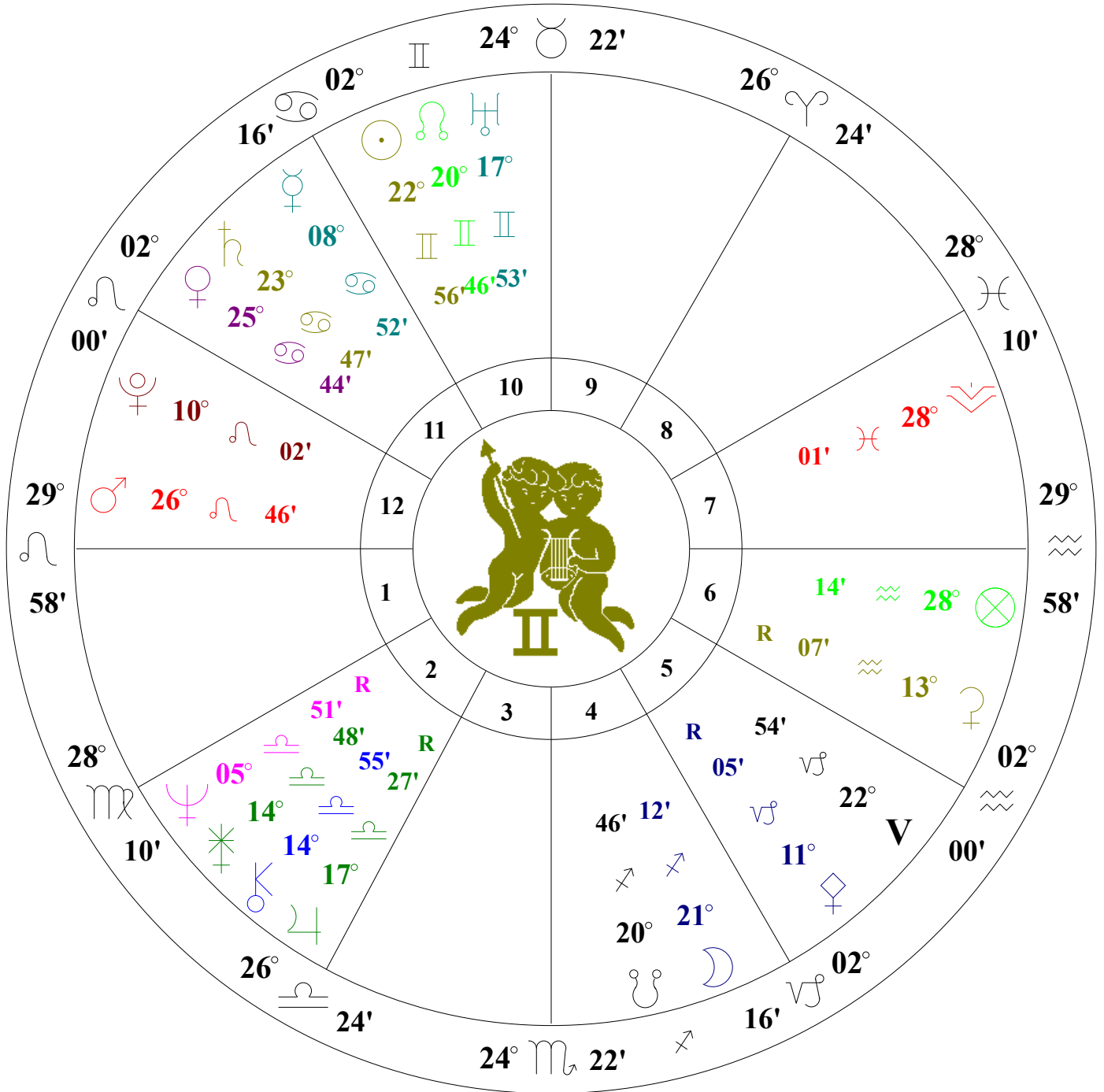

INTRODUCTION

This section reviews some of the technical aspects of astrology used to generate this report. If you wish to go directly to your personalised interpretations, skip this section and return to it at a later time. The personal information begins on page 5.

This report interprets your birth chart from the point of view of career factors in the horoscope. The material is drawn from four sources: (1) the astrological literature, (2) Carl Jung's writings on psychological types, (3) scientific research on vocation and the planets (especially the work of French statistician Michel Gauquelin), and (4) the author's experience as an astrologer over many years.

Many of the interpretations assume that you know your birth time accurately within a few minutes. If you are uncertain of the exact time, you can either cast a chart for SUNRISE of your date and place of birth or choose the UNKNOWN birth time feature of the program. The sunrise chart provides an informative general report for anyone born on the same date and in the same place on earth and offers a valuable perspective on vocational issues. Clicking on the Unknown time button calculates the Moon and planets for Noon for the place of birth, but places them in a solar houses chartwheel. The unknown time report omits interpretations for time-sensitive points.

This material is based on large statistical samples. Most people find that about 80% of the interpretations fit them closely whereas about 20% appear less applicable. If contradictory traits appear in the report, it is likely that both traits are aspects of your personality, but they are in conflict or vie with each other for expression. Astrology affords one of many perspectives on career potential. You should weigh the contents of this report with other sources of information such as your school record, job experience, vocational testing, your own sense of your likes and dislikes, and input from people who know you well. Astrology can guide you by suggesting options, but you alone have the ultimate responsibility to decide on a career path.

The birth chart outlines your potentials -- what you may become depending on how you develop your talents and confront your challenges and liabilities. It also helps you to identify your essential needs and chief motivations. The chart can both validate what you know of yourself and suggest further possibilities. It is up to each of us to weigh these factors in deciding on a career path that will be satisfying and promote personal growth. There are many paths open to each of us; our final destination depends on the choices we make along the way.

The natal horoscope taken in its entirety is a symbol of the person as a whole. Jung called this type of symbol a mandala. The signs of the zodiac represent twelve basic needs (and their corresponding challenges) that must be met in the course of human

development. A particular planet can occupy any of the twelve signs and thus has available twelve different modes (signs) for expressing its fundamental planetary drive or energy.

The houses of the horoscope symbolise the twelve broad areas of life where we seek to fulfil our basic needs. The planets signify the fundamental urges, drives, energies, or functions of the human personality. Each planet occupies a particular sign and a particular house. In addition, the planets make connections among themselves (the aspects) that clarify how these energies connect with each other. Soft aspects (sextiles, trines, and conjunctions of harmonious planets) show natural abilities and things that come our way easily without much toil. Hard aspects (squares, oppositions, and conjunctions of inharmonious planets) show challenges and talents that require work to develop but that may lead to significant achievements.

In vocational astrology the second, sixth, and tenth houses are the most important. The second house indicates what resources (talents, values, money, and assets) are at our disposal for developing our self-worth and making a living. The sixth house symbolises the work environment, our co-workers, and the type of day-to-day labour involved. The tenth house is the quintessential house of career and shows where we can become successful and achieve recognition in the eyes of the world. Pay careful attention to the second, sixth, and tenth houses when reading this report. Consider the signs on their cusps, the planets ruling those signs, and the planets within those houses.

Also consider the strengths and weaknesses of this type of information. A computer-generated interpretation can only list and describe the individual astrological factors in your chart, but it cannot synthesise them into a coherent story. You will need to put everything together into a meaningful whole that best fits your life experience and personal development. At some point, you may wish to consult a professional astrologer for further insight into your birth map.

An important key is to pay close attention to any themes that come up repeatedly in the report. Such recurring themes represent significant needs that must be met for you to have a satisfying career. In addition, because the planet Saturn is so closely linked to what we do in the world, it is especially useful to study the information about Saturn in your chart. In several places, there are lists of various occupations taken from the astrological literature. These job lists should be understood merely as illustrations of general principles rather than as specific recommendations of a career to pursue. It is not possible to pinpoint a single specific vocational choice in a horoscope.

Regarding the Gauquelin research, the author has found that Gauquelin's findings about the meanings of planets in high intensity zones generalise to planets that are emphasised in other ways, according to the rules of traditional astrology.

ASCENDANT AND CUSPS OF VOCATIONAL HOUSES

The horoscope is divided into twelve sections or "houses," which are patterned after the twelve signs of the zodiac. Each house represents a different area of life, and the sign of the zodiac on the cusp of each of the houses describes how we express the matters governed by that house. In vocational astrology, the most relevant houses are the First House whose cusp is the Ascendant, the Second House of income, the Sixth House of daily work, and the Tenth House of Career whose cusp is the Midheaven. The houses are derived from your exact date, time, and place of birth.

The Rising Sign or Ascendant

The Ascendant is the sign of the zodiac that intersects the eastern horizon at the moment of birth. It is closely linked to our sense of personal identity and reflects how we present ourselves to the world. Each sign can be described by its Quality (Cardinal, Fixed, Mutable), its Element (Fire, Earth, Air, Water), and its Polarity (Yin, Yang). Cardinal signs are outgoing and initiate activity; Fixed signs consolidate, build, and resist change; and Mutable signs are adaptable and make way for a new cycle. Fire signs are intuitive and inspirational; Earth signs are practical and dependable; Air signs are mental and communicative; and Water signs are sensitive and emotional. Yin signs are receptive and inner directed, whereas Yang signs are assertive and outer directed.

With Leo rising, you tend to be outgoing and assertive when it comes to getting your needs met. You take charge when you have to, and you are generally straightforward and direct in dealing with others. You have leadership potential and would make a good supervisor. In your work you most likely prefer security and established routines. You enjoy the process of building something and following it through to completion. You prefer to do things your own way and may have a problem delegating responsibility. A talent for business or finance is often present. You would do well in a career that allows you freedom and independence to pioneer and explore uncharted territory. An interest in teaching is common. You are likely to be extraverted, dramatic, and a bit feisty; and you may at times project an image that declares "I am the greatest."

Key phrases for Leo are "I will" and "I create." Leo's penchant for adornment is seen among jewellers, decorators, and cosmetologists. Because the Sun rules Leo, you may be drawn to work involving fire, light, heat, or illumination. In afflicted charts, career setbacks are likely to be due to arrogance, narrow-mindedness, passionate impulse, or feeling above the law.

Taurus Midheaven

Our vocation is shown by the tenth house, the sign and decan of its cusp (which is the Midheaven or MC in most house systems), the ruler(s) of the tenth, any planets therein, and any aspects involving tenth house planets, the tenth house ruler(s), or the MC.

Key phrases for Taurus are "I have," "I build," and "I possess." Your appreciation of quality, value, material goods, and excellent workmanship will assist in any career. Taurus indicates a great deal of patience, tenacity, organisation, practicality, and common sense. Success usually comes after a period of apprenticeship in which you master skills and lay firm foundations for future advancement. You have an innate talent for managing money and accumulating wealth. Most likely you would prefer a job that has a set routine and that allows you to feel comfortable and worthwhile. You may gain recognition for becoming the spokesperson of a particular system of values. Taurus is a sensual earthy sign and often works in a field that involves direct hands-on contact with the body or with material reality. The characteristic Taurus appreciation of nature, beauty, sexuality, luxury, peace, and harmony may also colour the choice of career.

Typical Taurus Midheaven occupations include banking, investing, finance, business, architecture, engineering, building, construction, property management, farming, agriculture, and gardening. The Taurean fondness for the human body and physical contact leads some to become medical doctors, hands-on healers, physical therapists, athletes, models, bodybuilders, gym teachers, masseurs, sexologists, and so on. Venus rules Taurus and may confer an interest in luxury items, the beauty industry, fashion, design, interior decorating, flower arrangement, art, fine foods, cooking, catering, or wine growing. Taurus rules the throat and may indicate a talent for singing, music, acting, or entertainment. In afflicted charts, career setbacks may be due to overindulgence, hedonism, rigidity, intolerance, possessiveness, vanity, dishonesty, or shady business dealings.

The sign, house, and aspects of Venus, which rules Taurus, will give further clues about career potentials in your chart. The same holds true for the decan ruler(s) described below.

THIRD DECAN: Because your Midheaven lies between 20 and 30 degrees of Taurus, your career comes under the influence of the third decan of Taurus, which is governed by CAPRICORN and Chaldean ruler SATURN. You have a good head for business and are capable of practical and constructive work that could spell success in fields related to building, manufacturing, mining, or farming. Gemini Intercepted in the Tenth House

An intercepted sign lies entirely within a house and differs from the sign on its cusp.

Key phrases for Gemini are "I think," "I move about," and "I communicate." People with Gemini in the tenth house gravitate toward occupations that make use of their cleverness, wit, restlessness, love of variety, and intellectual agility. Gemini is an adaptable, versatile, and communicative sign. You would do well in work that requires a certain amount of reading, studying, experimentation, and conveying your ideas to others. You enjoy being "on the go" and may choose a career that involves travel, movement, making contacts within the community, and becoming familiar with the local environment. Because Gemini (the twins) is a dual sign, you may find your time split between two jobs, two work places, or between a primary job and an income producing hobby. As Gemini rules the hands, your career may involve a certain amount of manual dexterity.

Gemini is prominent among writers, journalists, essayists, novelists, poets, teachers, counsellors, publishers, printers, dancers, musicians, inventors, perpetual students, and communicators. It reveals a talent for secretarial or clerical work and is often found in the charts of those employed in agencies or in jobs having to do with transport. The Gemini fondness for motion and communication may indicate a talent to any form of communicative self-expression that involves bodily motion. It is also common in the charts of those whose work involves entertainment, film, TV, aviation, aeronautics, meteorology, astronomy, travel, psychology, the law, computers, mathematics, and science. In afflicted charts, career setbacks may be due to fickleness, playing fast and loose with the truth, gullibility, scattered thinking, an unsettled or erratic lifestyle, or nervous tension.

Virgo Second House Cusp

Income and resources are shown by the second house, the sign (and decan) of its cusp, the ruler(s) of this house, any planets therein, and by any aspects involving second house planets, the second house ruler(s), or the cusp of the second house.

With Virgo here, you can benefit from work that requires patience, dedication, thoroughness, compartmentalisation, and meticulous attention to detail. You are a discriminating individual with excellent powers of analysis. You could do well in occupations that require manual dexterity, or technical and analytical ability. Jobs related to health, nutrition, diet, hygiene, or providing some type of service are especially appealing. Because Mercury rules Virgo, you can gain from work involving communications, travel, transport, commerce, or being on the go. Your ability to craft words can make you a fine speaker or writer. Typical Virgo-ruled occupations include teacher, editor, proof-reader, bookkeeper, typist, secretary, paralegal, bank teller, printer, engraver, guitarist, craftsperson, travel agent, computer programmer, technician, therapist, health care provider, mental health worker, and so on. Many with this position prefer to be second in command, or to work behind the scenes or in a subordinate position.

Aquarius Sixth House Cusp

Our daily work and working environment are shown by the sixth house, the sign (and decan) of its cusp, the ruler(s) of this house, any planets therein, and by any aspects involving sixth house planets, the sixth house ruler(s), or the cusp of the sixth house.

With Aquarius here, your work is likely to involve unusual or innovative activities that make use of your creativity, originality, and inventiveness. You should capitalise on any unique talents that make you stand out from the crowd. Income may be derived from working with computers, the Internet, electronics, modern technology, radio, TV, inventions, aviation, astronomy, astrology, alternative medicine, or New Age interests. There may be a talent for research, medicine, psychiatry, counselling, or advisory positions. Your ability for abstract, objective, mathematical, or theoretical thinking can make you a fine lawyer, scientist, engineer, accountant, mechanic, computer programmer, or inventor. Your humanitarian ideals may interest you in social work, political science, labour unions, civil service, or civil rights endeavours. With this position, there is frequently something quite unusual or out of the ordinary about your working environment.

Sun in Gemini

The Sun symbolises our core identity and basic life energy. For us to feel authentic, our careers must allow for expression of our Sun sign's creativity and will to be.

Keywords: versatile, inquisitive, clever, loquacious, communicative, curious, peripatetic, mercurial, witty, restless, playful, dextrous, logical, agile.

Gemini, the sign of the youthful Twins, is noted for its duality, curiosity, versatility, adaptability, cleverness, agility, restlessness, ingenuity, and quickness at picking up ideas. Mercury, the ruler of Gemini, is the messenger of the gods who governs speech, movement, travel, language, communication, circulation, and commerce. You excel at moving about and making connections and contacts with others. There is often a fondness for reading, writing, speaking, singing, lecturing, teaching, literature, and the skilful use of your native tongue. You need a job that allows for variety and diversity, and you are unlikely to stick with a routine or boring position. Gemini faults include a tendency to bite off more than you can chew and to be content with superficial understanding.

Typical Gemini occupations include educators, lecturers, lawyers, brokers, writers, editors, printers, public speakers, vocalists, interpreters, linguists, language teachers, analysts, statisticians, inspectors, spokespersons, reporters, publishers, librarians, secretaries, accountants, bankers, salespersons, advertising consultants, market researchers, diplomats, data processors, computer programmers, or any occupation that makes extensive use of linguistic ability, quick thinking, ingenuity, manual dexterity, and rapid motion. A prominent Gemini is especially common in the fields of journalism, education, and literature. There is often an interest in transport, commerce, vehicle maintenance, travel, mechanical and electronic gadgets, computers, aircraft, aeronautics, meteorology, and anything to do with conveyance or transportation. Runners, messengers, chauffeurs, taxi drivers, couriers, pilots, aeroplane or helicopter

mechanics, basketball or baseball players, and race car drivers frequently have a prominent Gemini.

In a statistical survey of sun signs by Paul Field (1964), quick-witted Gemini produced the largest number of lawyers and was also common among chemists (as were Libra and Taurus). In this survey, however, the Sun in Gemini produced the smallest number of aeroplane pilots. Geminis are generally flexible, versatile, and restless. Because they tend to scatter their energies by having too many irons in the fire, Geminis sometimes appear fickle or inconstant. As Gemini author Ralph Waldo Emerson put it, "a foolish consistency is the hobgoblin of little minds." Some well-known Geminis include President John F. Kennedy, Johnny Depp, Isadora Duncan, Bill Moyers, Ted Kaczynski, Marquis de Sade, Boy George, Donald Trump, Joyce Carol Oates, Salman Rushdie, Bob Dylan, Paul McCartney, Marilyn Monroe, and Judy Garland.

Further information about your basic motivational system can be found by studying the sign, house, and aspects of Mercury, the ruler of Gemini. The same holds true of the decan ruler(s) below.

THIRD DECAN: Your Sun lies between 20 and 30 degrees of Gemini (approximately June 11 - 20), your sense of identity and purpose in life is influenced by the third decan of Gemini, which is governed by AQUARIUS, URANUS, SATURN, and Chaldean, the SUN. The solar influence gives ambition, pride, a desire for recognition, and a fondness for power and authority. The Sun is also associated with jewellers and workers in precious metals. There is often a talent for literature, science, music, or the arts. The Aquarian influence gives a capacity for dispassionate thinking and often a talent for technical fields. Sun in the Tenth House

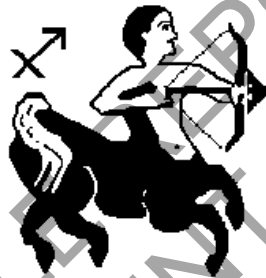
The Sun represents our individuality, willpower, and sense of self. The house occupied by the Sun reveals areas where we can feel authentic and express who we truly are.

A tenth house Sun denotes ambition and a desire to achieve a position that affords prominence, power, or social recognition. You may be interested in politics or the social sciences. Many with this placement prefer to be their own boss or to have a great deal of autonomy and independence on the job. You are likely to have executive or leadership ability, and others will respect your knowledge, expertise, and authority.

Your relationship with your father is likely to have an important bearing on your choice of career. Modesty is not likely to be one of your virtues, and you should avoid arrogance and narcissistic preoccupation with yourself.

Some with this position choose an occupation in which they can shine or enlighten others, either literally through lighting or electronics, or figuratively through endeavours like teaching, supervision, psychotherapy, film, entertainment, performance, comedy, illustration, higher education, scientific research, spiritual studies, mentoring, or other forms of increasing awareness. There is a good possibility of receiving some type of public honour or acknowledgement for your work. Through its rulership of Leo, the Sun may indicate an interest in careers involving creative self-expression, athletics, acting, directing, the performing arts, fun, recreation, speculative investing, banking, gold, jewellery, or work related to children. The house with Leo on its cusp will give further clues to a potential vocation.



Moon in Sagittarius

The Moon represents our feelings, emotions, capacity for empathy, psychological reactions, and habitual or subconscious patterning. It signifies our need for security and our mothering instincts -- how we feel about, nurture, and care for one another.

A Sagittarius Moon suggests that your somewhat shy exterior conceals a lively, energetic, optimistic, sociable, and outgoing personality. You have a strong sense of personal independence and an adventuresome spirit. There is often athletic ability and a fondness for exercise, physical activity, excitement, competition, sports, swimming, and the outdoors. A liking for animals and an enjoyment of travel are common. You may be interested in teaching, guidance counselling, higher education, the law, science, philosophy, religion, preaching, travel, foreign cultures, publishing, journalism, or broadcasting.

You are likely to be quite intuitive and visionary, with a natural ability to forecast or anticipate future trends. Your willingness to gamble or take risks may lead you to a career associated with investing, sales, gambling, speculation, the stock market, politics, big business, or entrepreneurial ventures. Artists, writers, musicians,

philosophers, and creative thinkers with this placement often produce emotionally stirring works of deep spiritual significance. Personal contact with the mentally ill sometimes gives an interest in psychiatry, psychology, social work, or any of the mental health professions.

Moon in the Fourth House

A fourth house Moon sensitises your emotions and enhances your intuition and psychic awareness. You are likely to have close family ties, to enjoy spending time at home, and to value tradition and psychological understanding. Some with this position prefer to work out of a home office or to run a business of their own. You may be skilled at cooking, baking, or other domestic activities. You have a strong appreciation of history, tradition, and the influence of the past on future development and behaviour. You might enjoy collecting antiques or historical relics.

The fourth house has to do with roots and foundations, and the Moon here indicates a need to understand where things originated and how they got to be the way they are. This is an excellent placement for historians, sociologists, psychoanalysts, anthropologists, criminologists, researchers, political scientists, psychologically oriented writers and filmmakers, and others who seek to understand or explain the origins and foundations of current attitudes and behaviour. You derive emotional satisfaction from work related to the provision of food, baked goods, shelter, clothing, domestic services, or emotional and spiritual sustenance to other people.

Mercury in Cancer

Mercury is the messenger of the gods. This first planet from the Sun represents our mind and thinking process -- how we learn, analyse, reason, and communicate. It also reveals how we use our hands, move our bodies, and explore our surroundings.

You have a reflective mind with excellent powers of retention, and you can be quite tenacious in learning about what you want to know. You appreciate tradition and probably enjoy studying history and the influence of the past on current developments. Being rather intuitive and perceptive, you readily tune into emotional nuances. Some may even consider you psychic. Your empathic ability is helpful for occupations in human relations, medicine, nursing, teaching, counselling, or the healing arts. You enjoy home, family, and domestic matters, and your work may involve cooking, landscaping and gardening, caring for animals, or looking after people.

Your imagination and colourful manner of self-expression often give rise to an enjoyment of music, art, song, or dance. A wanderlust or fondness for travel is not uncommon. Because of Cancer's association with the Fourth House, you may be

drawn to fields like ecology, meteorology, geology, environmental issues, or real estate. These outer planets spend many years travelling through each sign, and thus they tend to affect an entire generation. Only their house placements and close aspects are significant in the interpretation of an individual horoscope. Though not personally significant by itself, the sign placement of the three outer planets can reinforce similar traits found elsewhere in the horoscope.

Balance of Elements and Modalities

Introversion and Extraversion

Abundant Endings

Keywords: sensitive, caring, psychological, probing, insightful, healing, compassionate, private, committed, musical, artistic, spiritual, attuned to the mysteries of life and death

Many planets in houses 4, 8, or 12 suggest a career that meets the need for emotional involvement, caring, and sensitivity toward others. Such a career often deals with matters that are private, subconscious, personal, psychological, spiritual, or related to serving the needs of humanity. You have a strong desire to understand the hidden motivations of people and the underlying meanings of situations or events. You are likely to be highly receptive, intuitive, concerned, and empathic.

This occurs frequently in the charts of those who work closely or intimately with others (e.g., counsellors, therapists, etc.) and those who seek to master a topic in depth (e.g.,

You would prefer to be the captain of your ship or the conductor of your orchestra. Planets in Aspect

Introduction to Aspects

As mentioned in the Introduction, the planets signify fundamental urges, drives, or functions of the human personality. Astrologers have discovered that when planets either align (conjoin) or form certain configurations (angular patterns) with one another, a blending or combination of their energies occurs. These patterns are called "aspects" and are measured in terms of the angles formed by the planets.

The aspects are divided into major (0, 60, 90, 120, and 180 degrees) or minor (all other aspects, e.g., 30, 45, 72, 135, 144, 150 degrees, etc.). Major aspects are more evident and generally have a more profound effect on personality and vocation. The names of the aspects, according to the number of degrees between planets, are as follows. Major: 0 = conjunction, 60 = sextile, 90 = square, 120 = trine, and 180 = opposition. Minor: 30 = semi-sextile, 45 = semi-square, 72 = quintile, 135 = sesquiquadrate, 144 = biquintile, and 150 = inconjunct, or more properly the quincunx.

Aspects can be either easy or difficult. Of the major aspects, the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees) are considered easy or harmonious whereas the square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees) are considered difficult or stressful. The conjunction can be either easy or difficult depending on the nature of the planets involved. A planet involved in difficult aspects is considered "afflicted" since it carries some form of hardship through the difficult aspect.

In the next section, you will find a detailed description of the most significant aspects in your chart. At first reading, the large amount of material in this section may seem a bit overwhelming. Rather than get lost in the details, look for repeated themes that reinforce or clarify the earlier sections of this report.

The aspect descriptions below are arranged in order of "strength," which is a measure of whether the aspect is major (stronger) or minor (weaker) and how close the planets are to being at exactly the angle specified by the aspect. The closer the aspect is to exact, the stronger its influence is likely to be. However, if the planets involved in the aspect are strongly emphasised in your chart, then even a weak aspect between them can be quite significant.

Jupiter trine Uranus (Strength: 5.56)

Harmonious Jupiter/Uranus aspects indicate creativity, originality, inventiveness, and a fondness for travel and new experiences. There is often optimism, faith in oneself, and

leadership potential. Musical ability is common. Many with this aspect work in government positions or in the legal profession. Work abroad and contact with foreign cultures is also common.

Sun opposite Moon (Strength: 5.28)

Stressful Sun/Moon aspects indicate considerable intellectual ability that is hampered a measure of psychological conflict in which certain drives within the personality are pitted against one another. While growing up, you may have felt a lack of support or a sense that you somehow did not fit in to your family. In the career arena this can translate into the pursuit of an occupation that does not meet your needs or one that conflicts with what you truly want to do. Because of this rough edge in your personality, others may view you as self-willed, oppositional, contentious, argumentative, or imperious. You tend to feel easily frustrated and may be prone to periods of depression.

Mars conjunct Ascendant (Strength: 4.69)

Mars/Ascendant contacts suggest an interest in careers symbolised by the planet Mars, which governs physical and sexual energy, competition, assertiveness, penetration, cutting, and the use of fire and weapons. You are drawn to an occupation that requires courage, leadership, enterprise, a strong will, and abundant physical energy. The connection of Mars with Scorpio may give an interest in banking, finance, investing, psychology, investigation, occult studies, or in matters related to death and transformation. You value your independence and may prefer to be self-employed or the head of your own enterprise. A great deal of your drive and enthusiasm is directed toward career matters.

The Gauquelin research found a prominent Mars in the charts of soldiers, sports champions, scientists, physicians, and business leaders who started their own firms. It indicates stamina, courage, a capacity for hard work, and a desire to put decisions quickly into action.

Mars square Midheaven (Strength: 4.57)

Mars closely aspecting the Midheaven suggests that a great deal of energy and enthusiasm is available for vocational matters. On the job, you prefer to make your own decisions and may want to be your own boss. Your initiative, pioneering spirit, and love of challenge are definite assets. You like to develop new ideas and initiate new products and services. There is usually leadership potential and an ability to inspire or motivate other people to action.

The Gauquelin research found a prominent Mars in the charts of soldiers, sports champions, scientists, physicians, and business leaders who started their own firms. It indicates stamina, courage, a capacity for hard work, and a desire to put decisions quickly into action. Mars may also indicate work that makes use of Mars-governed items such as iron, heat, fire, sharp instruments, tools, weapons, and mechanical devices.

Through its rulership of Aries, Mars may suggest a career that requires stamina, assertiveness, taking risks, confronting danger, or the potential use of force. There may be an interest in police or the armed forces, firefighting, government or politics, competitive sports, emergency medicine, crisis intervention, human resources, engineering, weapons development, prosecuting attorney, and similar pursuits. If Mars is well aspected, you will be a persistent worker with a probing mind and a capacity for intense concentration. Scorpio likes to delve beneath the surface to understand and to foment radical changes. This placement favours medicine, surgery, acupuncture, psychology, psychoanalysis, chemistry, scientific research, sex therapy, and any of the healing professions. Other typical Scorpio occupations include mining, undertaking, banking, accounting, financial management, brewing, refuse collection, sewage maintenance, power generation, explosives, refrigeration, the meat trade, plumbing, and detective work. Psychic ability and a talent for divination are sometimes in evidence.

Venus conjunct Saturn (Strength: 4.05)

Venus/Saturn aspects suggest that you are serious, idealistic, and willing to make sacrifices for what you desire. You have a strong sense of duty, and you are happiest when meeting your responsibilities. Astrologer Charles Carter described these as aspects of "spiritual beauty, born of material hardship and the absence of the ordinary pleasures of life." Venus/Saturn aspects often indicate a need to deal with melancholy, despair, loss, loneliness, or low self-esteem in order to be truly successful in your life. The discipline of Saturn combines with the grace of Venus to confer a sense of balance and harmony, an ability to adjust relationships, and often artistic or musical ability. This aspect is common in the charts of musicians, attorneys, counsellors, advisors, and therapists.

Moon opposite Uranus (Strength: 3.69)

Moon/Uranus aspects often indicate musical talent, originality, and technical ability. There may have been something odd or erratic in your emotional life, especially in your relationship with your mother, which has affected your career path. The detachment of Uranus combined with the Moon's emotionality may manifest as a kind of cool, or even icy, brilliance. Others may view you as revolutionary.

Saturn sextile Midheaven (Strength: 3.43)

With Saturn closely aspecting the Midheaven, you tend to be ambitious, thoughtful, serious, persistent, and hard working in career matters. Because of your high standards and dedicated effort, you may assume significant responsibilities on the job. Many with this aspect experience a slow but steady rise to a position of leadership, expertise, or authority. Organisational and management ability is common. You have good concentration and are probably a bit of a perfectionist. Your work may involve the application of specialised rules or techniques. The Gauquelin research found that both Saturn and Mars were prominent in the charts of scientists and physicians, but that both planets were under-emphasised in the births of actors, writers, and painters of fine art.

Through its rulership of Capricorn, Saturn may give an interest in government, political science, administration, supervision, or strategic planning. There is often a talent for technical work or practical application of various scientific fields including chemistry, biology, engineering, physics, mathematics, and medical research. Through its co-rulership of Aquarius, Saturn can indicate occupations related to technology, computers, research, inventions, electronics, counselling, psychiatry, alternative medicine, humanitarian causes, astrology, or New Age interests.

Mercury square Neptune (Strength: 2.98)

Mercury/Neptune contacts indicate an active imagination, sensitive perceptions, and heightened intuition. Your mind is open to the more subtle and spiritual aspects of reality. You have a gift for sensing public moods and anticipating future trends. In adversarial relationships, you readily sense your opponent's motives and potential strategic moves. This skill is useful for fields as diverse as diplomacy, creative writing, journalism, marketing, financial investing, military planning, and psychic investigation. The creative imagination of Neptune often indicates a talent for art, music, poetry, literature, painting, sketching, acting, film, photography, and so on. You may also have an interest in studying Neptune-ruled matters such as oils, gases, chemicals, medicines, or anything involving the feet.

Stressful Mercury/Neptune aspects indicate an astute and cunning mind. Venus sextile Midheaven (Strength: 2.62)

You are likely to be popular and may pursue a type of work that appeals to public tastes. This is sometimes an indication of artistic, musical, poetic, or other creative talent. Through its rulership of Libra, Venus may point to a career involving diplomacy, politics, the law, arbitration, mediation, consulting, counselling, psychology, partnerships, contracts, public relations, art, fashion, design, or decorating. Many with this aspect provide some type of expert service to clients on a one-to-one basis. You are able to see all sides of an issue, negotiate differences, and come to a reasonable compromise. Through its rulership of Taurus, Venus may suggest an occupation related to the beauty or fashion industry, luxury goods, financial management, career counselling, program development, farming, building, or work dedicated to helping people develop their human potentials.

Mercury semi-square Midheaven (Strength: 2.51)

Mercury closely aspecting the Midheaven indicates a knack for communicating and giving voice to new ideas. You love variety in your work and may be interested in education, journalism, counselling, preaching, teaching, languages, editing, singing, computer programming, consulting, literature, filmmaking, the law, and similar pursuits that make use of the written or spoken word. You can be quite witty and probably have a good sense of humour. There is often manual dexterity and a fondness for travel and keeping on the go. You can succeed at occupations that require you to talk, write, type, or spend time on the phone; to gather, analyse, distribute, or report news and information; to utilise your fine motor skills; and to stay mentally and physically active. Intellectual stimulation is especially important and may lead to work with computers or in a scientific or technical field.

Mercury rules all forms of transport and communication and may give an interest in vehicles, aircraft, aviation, telecommunications, the Internet and computer networking, acoustics, lighting, lecturing, and other ways that we convey people, knowledge, or things. Through its rulership of Virgo, Mercury may signify a job related to health care, psychotherapy, therapeutics, or any of the service professions. You may also be good

at work that requires you to follow intricate rules or to keep track of multiple details. Many fine chefs, artisans, jewellers, and craftspeople share this aspect.

Sun conjunct Uranus (Strength: 1.96)

Your inventiveness and creative originality will make you shine, and others may seek to emulate your unique abilities. Sun/Uranus aspects increase your zeal, wilfulness, independence of thought, revolutionary tendencies, and belief in the value of your own opinions. Others see you as standing for some definite cause, and they tend to accept your authority and follow your leadership. Uranus symbolises human freedom and humanitarian ideals, and when linked to your Sun, it gives a strong sense of personal liberty and a desire to defend the rights of others. You probably have a dramatic flair and a compelling manner of expressing your ideas. Uranus typically indicates an unconventional and gifted intellect, scientific or technological interests, iconoclasm, and a streak of rebelliousness and eccentricity. An interest in unusual or unexplained phenomena is not uncommon.

You need a career that allows you to march to the beat of your own drum, without undue interference from others. This aspect is frequent in the charts of innovative thinkers, literary figures, scientists, teachers, educators, politicians, statesmen, maverick leaders, rock musicians, civil rights activists, military generals, astronauts, civil servants, and those who pursue unconventional or groundbreaking careers. You are truly a horse of a different colour. If this conjunction forms stressful aspects, it suggests the need to seek wise counsel to insure a prudent course of action. Otherwise, at especially critical junctures in your career, you run the risk of shooting yourself in the foot by engaging in precipitous, dictatorial, or stubborn behaviours, based on a foolish sense of pride.

Saturn quintile Neptune (Strength: 1.95)

Saturn quintile Neptune indicates much idealism and a capacity for hard work. It may reflect a talent for music, mathematics, or any activity that requires precise timing, rhythm, and order. You value artistic creations and may work to preserve them for future generations. There is sometimes great ambition, a desire to assume a position of authority or leadership, and a sense of fulfilling a special role in society. An interest in medicine, nursing, psychology, psychiatry, scientific or medical research, or fields related to human health and welfare is common. Your career may involve Neptunian matters related to art, drama, stage, film, photography, fashion, design, illusion, magic, oil, gas, chemicals, or the sea. You probably like animals and may be involved in activities such as horseback riding or veterinary medicine.

Uranus quintile Ascendant (Strength: 1.93)

Uranus aspecting the Ascendant reveals a person who is progressive, free thinking, independent, and sometimes a bit eccentric or revolutionary. Tradition and orthodoxy do not bind you. Instead, you are capable of novel insights and you appreciate alternative ways of viewing reality. Health care workers with this aspect often utilise techniques of alternative or non-traditional medicine (e.g., meditation, hypnosis, acupuncture, etc.). There may be a talent for science, mathematics, chemistry, technology, electronics, or computer-related subjects. Your capacity for objective and impartial thinking can lead to success as a counsellor, advisor, social scientist, political activist, attorney, social worker, psychologist, or psychiatrist. A prominent Uranus is also common in the charts of astrologers and others with New Age, unorthodox, or occult interests. The main problem with this aspect is a tendency to be stubborn and fixed in your opinions as well as a proneness to say or do shocking things that upset or surprise other people.

Sun semi-square Pluto (Strength: 1.89)

The Sun aspecting Pluto indicates great emotional intensity, the courage of your convictions, and the determination to succeed or assume a position of authority. Pluto is lord of the underworld, and the life becomes a series of deaths and rebirths, at least on a psychological level. Your sense of identity is closely linked to a need for power and control. This is a powerful aspect because it links your sense of self, represented by the Sun, with Pluto's capacity for both radical transformation and massive destruction. Your work may involve you with matters related to birth, death, sex, power, control, elimination, or rejuvenation. You have a unique capacity to get to the root of things. An interest in medicine or healing is common. Psychic ability is sometimes indicated.

In the work arena, you must come to terms with a tendency to get into power struggles or angry confrontations with co-workers or with those in authority.

If you assume a supervisory position, you must learn to relate to others without being excessively demanding, jealous, biased, or dictatorial. Many with this aspect are drawn to working with crisis situations that bring them into contact with the darker, sinister, or violent side of human nature (e.g., police work, criminology, psychology, psychiatry, etc.). A talent for managing other people's money or resources is common. You could also do well in work that involves any type of in-depth investigation or scientific research, especially atomic power. In afflicted charts, this can indicate an almost fanatical desire to have others do your bidding. It can also represent an over-reliance on symbolic or actual sexual prowess to shore up your self-esteem.

Moon trine Mars (Strength: 1.77)

Moon/Mars aspects make you courageous, enterprising, robust, daring, outgoing, and enthusiastic. You are likely to be direct in your speech and pragmatic in your thinking. There is often great physical and sexual energy, bodily vigour, athletic ability, and a love of life. Good looks and sex appeal are also common. Your ambition, drive, and assertiveness can lead to success in politics, sports, education, or business. Some with this aspect dislike discipline and feel a need to rebel, reform, or revolutionise. A capacity for profound and penetrating thought is often present. The down side is a tendency to go to extremes, take unnecessary risks, or otherwise behave in a self-indulgent or impulsive manner.

Sun sextile Mars (Strength: 1.54)

Sun/Mars aspects enhance your courage, assertiveness, leadership, decisiveness, independence, and love of power. You are a pioneer who seeks an exciting career that will allow expression of your natural enthusiasm, energy, entrepreneurial drive, and crusading spirit. When you stand up for your beliefs and values, you inspire others to follow your lead. You like being in charge and would probably feel stifled in a routine job or a subordinate position. You enjoy adventure and competition, and may be interested in Mars-related careers like the police, the military, surgery, medicine, sports, politics, debate, and so on. Mars rules adrenaline and testosterone, so you may be drawn to careers that involve an element of risk, danger, competition, conflict, or daring. The Rambo movie character would have this aspect in his chart.

Sun trine Jupiter (Strength: 1.52)

Sun/Jupiter aspects are generally a kindly and benevolent influence, and are common in charts of those who pursue a career in one of the professions (medicine, law, university professor, etc.). You are likely to be quite intelligent, and capable of significant intellectual achievements. There may be talent for writing, teaching, or publishing; and there is often a fondness for horses and other large animals. You can benefit from ninth and twelfth house matters such as publishing, broadcasting, religion, spirituality, mental health, philosophy, occult studies, foreign interests, journeys, the sea, the law, literature, medicine, and the sciences. It can also signal success in sports, or in a military or naval career. This aspect is one of the indicators of success and prominence in one's career. People of influence or authority are likely to assist you along the way.

Moon sextile Jupiter (Strength: 1.25)

Moon/Jupiter aspects indicate a person who is good-humoured, kindly, sensitive, compassionate, and generous. Your natural friendliness and personal appeal make you a good salesperson. Good business sense is common. There is often

restlessness, a liking for change and travel, and a fondness for ease and comfort. You tend to be very imaginative and may enjoy fiction, literature, or philosophical speculation. Others appreciate your ability to spin a good yarn. Difficulties can arise through self-indulgence, and special care should be taken to use alcohol or drugs only in moderation. Although you are likely to come in contact with the wealthy, you may be impractical or imprudent about personal spending and other financial matters. Career opportunities are likely to come through women.

Sun semi-sextile Saturn (Strength: 1.14)

Sun/Saturn contacts bring focus and discipline to your self-expressive and assertive drives. Saturn prudently regulates the vitality and life force of the Sun. There is a serious cast to your personality, plus great ambition, discretion, determination, and organisational ability. You have a highly developed sense of duty, tremendous powers of concentration, and a capacity for hard work and persistent effort. Some with this aspect become loners who prefer to work privately or alone, or pursue careers that require years of study and depth of thought. Saturn gives a desire to build and construct, to establish order, to lay firm foundations, and to control or govern responsibly in a moral and cautious manner.

There is frequently a knack for business, organisation, and management. Because Saturn signifies rules, regulations, codes of conduct, structure, and disciplined thinking, you might consider a career involving government, administration, business, banking, the law, teaching, science, computer programming, mathematics, accounting, or library science. This aspect often indicates self-made individuals who achieve success and recognition as a result of their own efforts. You may go through a long period of apprenticeship with low wages on your way to eventual success. Hardships early on, or difficulties with one of your parents, may spur you to great accomplishments as an adult, but you may need to exercise caution against callous, ruthless, or calculating behaviour toward others.

Jupiter biquintile Midheaven (Strength: 1.09)

Jupiter closely aspecting the Midheaven makes one proud, ambitious, expansive, optimistic, independent, and adventurous. There is often leadership ability, a lust for life, courage, and a fair amount of personal vanity. Some with this position have a commanding presence, exude an air of expertise or authority, and enjoy putting on a grand performance. In the Gauquelin research, a prominent Jupiter was common in the charts of actors, politicians, journalists, and playwrights. When combined with a strong Mars, a prominent Jupiter favoured executive and military positions. Jupiter, however, tended to be weak in the charts of physicians and scientists whose charts instead showed a strong Mars and Saturn.

Through its rulership of Sagittarius, Jupiter may give an interest in higher education, philosophy, religion, the law, social science, long-distance travel, exploration, publishing, broadcasting, forecasting, sports, the outdoors, and foreign languages or cultures. Through its co-rulership of Pisces, Jupiter may indicate careers related to illusion, art, music, song, film, dance, writing, creative imagination, chemicals, drugs, alcohol, spirituality, mysticism, divination, charity, healing, mental health, psychology, hospital or prison work, or caring for the ill or disadvantaged members of society.

THE SATURN CYCLE: YOUR CAREER PEAKS AND VALLEYS

Our careers undergo cyclic changes that parallel the movement of Saturn through the birth chart. The 29-1/2 year Saturn cycle can be divided into four 7-1/3-year quarter cycles. As Saturn crosses the IC at the bottom of the chart, we begin to ride the wave upward from a period of subjective preoccupation and worldly obscurity to a new cycle of vocational growth. During the first and second quarters, which last just under 15 years, we establish, build, and develop our new career directions. When Saturn then crosses the MC at the top of the chart, we reach a career peak and consolidate our gains. We are now on the downward slope of the wave (the third and fourth quarters of this Saturn cycle). About seven years after Saturn conjoins the MC, we go through another period of intense vocational activity, just as Saturn is crossing into the final quarter, which is a seven-year stretch of relative obscurity, inner reflection and reassessment. We then start a new 29-1/2 year career cycle as Saturn again crosses the IC. The section below gives specific details based on a horoscope cast for your date, time, and place of birth.

In 1940, Grant Lewi published his groundbreaking analysis of Saturn's influence on career. Saturn takes about 29-1/2 years to complete a journey around the zodiac. During the time when Saturn crosses the 4th house cusp or IC (the "bottommost" or "darkest" point in the horoscope), Lewi noted that people "either fade completely from the picture, or take a new start in life, depending on their age and other considerations" in the chart. This is similar to a New Moon, a time of darkness and new beginnings. During the period from 1970 to 2050 covered in this report, the approximate dates of Saturn's passage through SCORPIO are DECEMBER 1982 - NOVEMBER 1985, then OCTOBER 2012 - SEPTEMBER 2015, and finally NOVEMBER 2041 - OCTOBER 2044. At some point during these years Saturn will cross your IC, marking the end stages of a period of vocational obscurity. Saturn's passage through the sign at the bottom of your chart SIGNALS A NEW BEGINNING OR A CHANGE OF DIRECTION IN YOUR CAREER.

Astrologer Don Jacobs further elaborated Lewi's findings. According to Jacobs, the first quarter cycle (the 7-1/3-years when Saturn is travelling through roughly the fourth, fifth, and sixth houses as it approaches a square to the Midheaven) is a time of career "building." During this first phase we are establishing a new career or laying the foundations for a new direction in our current occupation. Jacobs calls the second

quarter cycle (the next 7-1/3-years, beginning when Saturn squares the Midheaven to transit roughly the seventh, eighth and ninth houses) the period of "triumph" when the efforts of the period of building are starting to pay off.

About 14 1/2 years after crossing the IC or fourth house cusp, Saturn reaches the Midheaven, the "highest" and "brightest" point of the horoscope. This is similar to a Full Moon and marks a peak in our career development. **IN YOUR CHART, A CAREER PEAK WILL OCCUR WHEN SATURN PASSES THROUGH TAURUS**, the sign on your Midheaven. During the period from 1970 to 2050 covered in this report, the approximate dates of Saturn's passage through TAURUS are FEBRUARY 1999 to APRIL 2001 and again from APRIL 2028 to JUNE 2030. These years are a time of achievement, accomplishment, harvest, recognition, and the assumption of new responsibilities. You reap the rewards of all the work you have done for the past fourteen years. However, if you have cut corners or prepared badly, the time has now come to pay the piper.

After passing the Midheaven, Saturn goes through a roughly 7-1/3-year period when it transits the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth houses (the third quarter cycle) as it approaches a square to the Midheaven. Jacobs calls this the period of "coasting" when we enjoy the fruits of our career success at the Midheaven. The final 7-1/3-year period commences with Saturn's square to the Midheaven and continues as it transits the first, second, and third houses. Jacobs calls this the period of "obscurity" when we become self-absorbed and directed inward, contemplating our lives and thinking about future possibilities. This subjective, inner period ends when Saturn again crosses the IC and begins a new cycle.

Prominent Chart Factors

THE MOST ACTIVE PLANETS, SIGNS, & HOUSES

The following section lists the most prominent or active planets, points (Ascendant and Midheaven), signs, and houses in your horoscope. Because the houses are determined by the exact time of birth, dominant houses are not calculated for charts with unknown birth times. You naturally tend to express the energy and symbolism of these planets, signs, and houses in most aspects of your life, including your vocation. The rating system used here is based on the number and closeness of the aspects formed by each of the planets and points.

The dominant planets and points (Ascendant, Midheaven) reveal your basic drives and natural aptitudes that can be developed for their career potential. Below are descriptions of the planets and points that are most active in your horoscope.

Mars Dominant (Strength: 26.52)

A prominent Mars indicates energy, ambition, assertiveness, leadership, daring, enthusiasm, self-motivation, and an ability to motivate others. Mars represents a hard-headed masculine energy that can lead to success in fields like surgery, sports, engineering, psychology, science, finance, investigation, police work, legal prosecution, forensics, munitions, firefighting, or any area -- physical or intellectual -- that involves cutting, penetration, competition, taking charge, muscular exertion, athletic ability, sexual prowess, swift energetic motion, or the use of force or violence. Mars governs fire, iron and steel, and occupations that utilise precision cutting tools, combustion, explosives, weapons, or mechanical devices. Mars excels at tasks that require initiative and independent enterprise. The Gauquelin research found a strong Mars in the charts of executives, soldiers, physicians, scientists, sports champions, and business leaders who started their own firms.

If Mars is engaged in stressful aspects, you need to guard against acting too rashly, impulsively, selfishly, or aggressively on the job. Make a special effort to respect the rights of others.

Sun Dominant (Strength: 26.29)

You believe in yourself and have a strong desire to shine, inspire or uplift others, and illuminate the world around you. The energy and enthusiasm of the Sun can lead to success in competitive sports, entertainment, administration, politics, banking,

self-employment, entrepreneurial endeavours, the performing arts, stage, film, fashion, photography, or creative endeavours. An interest in matters related to power, force, combustion, fire, and energy is not uncommon. You like to be in command and may prefer to be your own boss. You are a born leader and can excel in whatever you put your mind to. Celebrities often have a prominent Sun in their charts.

If the Sun is involved in many stressful aspects, you may have a tendency to act in an arrogant or overbearing manner in the workplace. You must learn to practice humility and to avoid any tendency toward obstinate or domineering behaviour with others.

Ascendant Dominant (Strength: 25.72)

The Ascendant, the point of the zodiac that is coming up on the eastern horizon at your time of birth, represents how you present yourself to others as a physical and social being.
